

## Track And Field Records Strong Performance At Redbird Invitational

Wall, Savegnago and Bostert earn first-place finishes at the meet on Saturday.

**Normal, Ill.** - Juniors Monique Bostert and Andy Wall led the UIC men's and women's track and field team for the second straight meet with first-place finishes at the Redbird Invitational on Saturday afternoon.

Bostert placed first and broke the school record in the weight throw for the second straight weekend with a personal-best mark of 17.03 meters.

Newcomer Aimee Schuh finished fourth in the 60-meter hurdles (9.56), sixth in the high jump (1.45m) and seventh in the long jump (4.94m).

Constance Sciacero led the women's squad in the high jump with a fourth-place finish.

Wall placed in the top two in three events. The junior earned first place in 60-meter hurdles with a personal-best time of 8.54. The Peoria, Ill native also grabbed first in the triple jump (14.19m) and placed second in the high jump (1.95m).

Mike Savegnago earned the Flames their third first-place award with a 4.56-meter mark in the pole vault. Erik Perez and Matt Zaluckyj rounded out the meet with third and fourth-place finishes in the 800-meter run.

The track and field team is back in action next weekend at the University of Chicago Duals in Chicago, Ill.
