

Bastian Harbo Named Horizon League Tennis Player Of The Week

Stellar play against Indiana State guides junior to first weekly league honor.

CHICAGO - UIC's Bastian Harbo was named the Horizon League men's tennis player of the week for the period ending February 23, the league office announced on Wednesday.

The Oslo, Norway native is in the midst of a three-match winning streak in singles, defeating foes from Wright State, Bradley, and most recently defeated Indiana State's Joshua Smith in straight sets, 6-3, 6-3, this past weekend.

Harbo has also had success in doubles this season as well, teaming up with freshman Dave Robare against the Sycamore's Mpiloenhle Migogo and Milos Pavlovic for an 8-4 victory on February 21.

As a sophomore in 2008, Harbo set a new school record with 21 singles wins in a season.

Harbo and the men's tennis squad returns to action this weekend against Wayne State at home on February 28 at 6 p.m. at the Hinsdale Racquet Club.
